

## uncle George's Lost Tiki Cocktail Recipe

## Manifest of Contents

This package can be played by multiple sequential households. It contains enough of each ingredient to make 12 cocktails total. The following is a list of all the contents so that it can be checked for completeness before being sent on to the next household.

* There is a video showing the reassembly here: K8Baldwin.com/Tiki/Reassembly Careful reassembly is only necessary if it's going directly to the next player. If it's going back to kate, she can take care of the careful reassembly.
* Kraft brown button-and-string envelope tucked under the "Tiki Bar" wooden sign Letter from the employees and owners of the Greatest Tiki Bar in the Midwest key to the brass fish lock with a wooden tag reading, "Fin \& Eye"
* Basket hamper with wooden "Tiki Bar" sign on the top and locked with brass fish padlock (The key is in the button-and-string envelope)


## Fish Padlock

The key is in the button-and-string envelope, and it should be inserted under the swiveling pectoral fin of the fish. Then, the key needs to be turned while simultaneously pressing the eye button of the fish on the other side. Re-locking is the same process (button must be pressed).
\#1-labeled round basket of bar snacks
Starts off with 12 baggies of nuts, one for each person
There is a note inside reading, "Bar Snacks. Enjoy a bag of Nuts"
\#l-labeled brown striped sack of candle supplies
coconut fiber cylinder holder with green ribbon and a wooden note reading, "Set the Mood". The inside lid of the container reads, "Remove candle holder from this padded holder before lighting"

Blue glass candle holder
Book of matches with QR code on inside leading to mood music
Plastic baggies of tea light candles
small wooden slide-open box with inlay design (made by Heartwood Creations)
Yellow note with website link to candle video
Battery-powered LED tea light

\#-labeled brown striped sack with gold lock set to 0-0-0 (correct combo is 8-8-8)

2 green reed work surface mats
Bar rag / tea towel
Clear plastic scooper with $1 / 2$ cup marked
Gold measuring jigger
2 wooden stir spoons
Note reading, "Set up a workspace with these tools"
\#2-labeled magnetically-locked wooden box with sun face engraving
2 tall tiki-themed glasses
Note on the inside lid reading, "The Calamorpho cocktail should be prepared in a
tall, clear, glass. etc etc."
\#2-labeled rolled bundle of coconut fiber matting with cream tie carved wooden Tiki Totem with moon engraving on bottom
\#3-labeled blue leather/suede pouch
2 identical coaster larger parts
\#3-labeled green leather/suede pouch
2 identical coaster smaller parts (or the larger parts, one or the other)
Wooden note reading, "2 Coasters." (doesn't matter which leather pouch it's in.)
\#3-labeled brown and gold swirls sack with light blue letter-based padlock, dialed to "LOCK" to start (the correct combo is TIDE)

750 ml plastic bottle of Malibu Rum
75 ml plastic bottle of Seedlip Grove 42 non-alcoholic alternative Note reading, "Add 202 of your choice of either Malibu Rum or Seedlip etc etc"
\#4-labeled brown sack
kukui nut lei necklace
\#4-labeled banana pouch with yellow padlock, set to 000 (Correct combo is
7-5-7. To re-lock, it also has to be set at 7-5-7.)
Blue little mesh pouch
Starts off with 12 glass vials full of red cabbage powder, as people play, some will be empty
Accordion-folded up note reading, "Add into your Rum or Seedlip, 3/64 tsp of Red cabbage Powder etc etc"
Plastic baggie of toothpicks labeled "Powder Prods"

Page 2 of 4
\#5-labeled sack with blue and yellow palm trees
1602 plastic bottle of NaOH (lye)
Wooden note reading, "For a rum drink: - add 1 Oz of 1,000 PPM NaOH solution. For a non-alcoholic Seedlip drink: - add 2 Oz of 1,000 PPM NaOH solution etc"
\#6-labeled locked treasure chest set to 0-0-0 (correct combo is 4-3-0. To re-lock, it also has to be set at 4-3-0.)

Starts with 6 full cans of calamansi juice, as people play, some will be empty Note that says, "Add $1 / 2$ cup of Calamansi juice etc etc."
\#6-labeled coconut zipped purse
5 dominoes with pink stickers
6 dominoes with yellow stickers
8 dominoes with green stickers
\#7-labeled blue 1-cup collapsible scoop (just loose in the hamper)
Attached wooden note reading, "one scoop of that which gets wetter the longer it basks in the sun."
\#8-labeled small wooden box with snap lid
Eye-dropper bottle of bitters in decorative green string netting Note on the inside lid reading. "For the missing piece I would delve. etc etc"
\#9-labeled black wooden box with blue padlock and brass canister on chain (correct combo is Right, up, up, Down)

Cloth zipper sack with combination lock set to 0-0-0 (correct combo is 4-5-7), and a dangling wood note reading: K8Baldwin.com/TikiWin

Baggie of anise stars and
Decorative butterfly stakes
Bamboo skewers of dried fruit
Biodegradable straws with green leaves
Note reading, "Add these included garnishes to the drink etc," and your list of accomplishments
Outer black wooden box: Brass canister hung on the chain, can be twisted open on top or bottom

Note inside: "Your Tiki drink is not complete. etc etc"
Outer black wooden box: The leather loop at the end of the chain should go through the hasp to keep it locked. The pad lock goes through this loop and the blue ring.
